Raku Pottery Art Grant



The Grant's purpose was to have a collaboration between our Middle School and Archbishop Murphy High School in providing a pottery experience for our elementary students. After Karen Towey trained both groups in the technique of Raku pottery, our Middle School students taught the technique to rest of the school (Pre-school-5th grade).
