Sixth Grade—Students are required to have a measles booster and hepatitis immunization by August 31

These shots are available through private doctors or the County Public Health Dept.

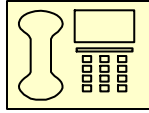

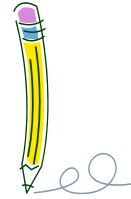
